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Production Manager Workshop – Children’s TV

Description

This comprehensive course covers all aspects of the Production Manager’s role from pre-production to post within Children’s TV. It takes the form of tutorials, group discussions and offsite exercises allowing participants to put into practice the skills they have learnt.

The course is broken down into 4 parts. Classroom based learning, offsite learning, assessments and mentoring.

You will be taught in a classroom environment for 2 days covering all aspects needed for Production Management with an emphasis on interaction, shared experience and a thorough foundation of the skills required for one of the most exciting and rewarding jobs within TV and film.

At the end of the two days you will be given a brief for a shoot that you will need to manage. You will be required to create a full shooting pack and workflow for a new production. You will be required to log into a secure server to complete the offsite learning.

This will then be assessed by the tutor and other participants in a one-day overview classroom session. You will also have access to the tutor after the training has ended for additional support.

Who’s it for?

Individuals working as Production Assistants/Coordinators or at equivalent levels, with at least one year’s experience, who are aiming to further their careers and move up to become Production Manager.

Duration & Class size
